

# PARALLEL VS. RELATIVE KEYS

Parallel Keys are the major and minor keys that share the same tonic. For example, D Major and D Minor.

Relative Keys are the major and minor keys that share the same key signature. For example, D Major and B Minor.

*More examples: A Major and F Sharp Minor, G Major and E Minor*
